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Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Bloomer was called to order on Wednesday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at 5:15 p.m. at City Hall, 1503 Main Street – Mayor Koehler presiding.

Roll call was taken: Mayor Koehler, Aldermen Meinen, Bauch, Reischel, Baribeau, Administrator Frion and Attorney Gierhart were present.

All present gave pledge to the flag.

Alderman Reischel made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 21<sup>st</sup> annual reorganization and regular meeting minutes with the modification of changing the motion on the Police Commission to Alderman Meinen making original the motion. Alderman Meinen seconded the motion and all present voted aye.

Alderman Bauch made a motion to approve all claims against the City and Utilities as presented. Alderman Baribeau seconded the motion and all present voted aye. The claims were in the amounts listed below:

Alderman Bauch made a motion to approve a Temporary Class “B” and “Class B” license for the Bloomer Community Club at the Bloomer Fairgrounds on August 5<sup>th</sup> – August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020 with a live music license on August 6<sup>th</sup> from 7 -11 p.m., August 7<sup>th</sup> from 7:30 p.m. - 12:30 a.m., August 8<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 p.m. – 1:00 a.m., and August 9<sup>th</sup> from 2:00 – 6:00 p.m. Alderman Baribeau seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Reischel made a motion to approve a Temporary Class “B” and “Class B” license for the Bloomer Community Club on August 29<sup>th</sup> at the Bloomer Fairgrounds with a live music license from 2:00 – 8:00 p.m. Alderman Bauch seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Reischel made a motion to approve a Temporary Class “B” and “Class B” license for Bloomer Community Visitors, Inc. on Sept. 12<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> with a live music license on Sept. 12<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 – 11:00 p.m. Alderman Meinen seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Meinen made a motion to approve a license to serve fermented malt beverages and intoxicating liquors for Melissa A. Soden and Rebecca D. Sly. Alderman Reischel seconded the motion. Motion carried.
