Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Bloomer was called to order on Wednesday, April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, 1503 Main Street – Mayor Steinmetz presiding.

Roll call was taken: Mayor Steinmetz, Aldermen Meinen, Bauch, Reischel, Koehler and Administrator Frion were present. Attorney Gierhart was absent.

All present gave pledge to the flag.

Alderman Meinen made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 25<sup>th</sup> regular meeting as presented. Alderman Reischel seconded the motion and all present voted aye.

Alderman Koehler made a motion to approve all claims against the City and Utilities as presented. Alderman Reischel seconded the motion and all present voted aye. The claims were in the amounts listed below:

The City had a 47% turnout for the April Presidential Preference. Absentee ballot requests were up due to the COVID epidemic. The reorganizational meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 21<sup>st</sup> at 5:00 p.m.

Alderman Meinen made a motion to approve resolution #02-20 authorizing the issuance and sale of up to \$1,464,670 sewerage system revenue bonds for the tertiary treatment project. Alderman Bauch seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Koehler made a motion approving the Financial Assistance Agreement with the State of Wisconsin Clean Water Fund program for the tertiary treatment project. Alderman Reischel seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Meinen made a motion to approve the bid from Mark Boettcher in the amount of \$110/acre for 2020 rent of industrial land. Alderman Reischel seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Motion by Alderman Meinen to adjourn. Alderman Koehler seconded the motion. Motion carried.
